## COURSE DESCRIPTION



# HOLE 1

**Long Par 5 requiring a well-placed tee shot. This is a true 3 shot par 5 considered by many to be the most difficult hole on the course.**



## **HOLE 2**

**Short Par 4 dogleg left with a large bailout on the right side of the fairway.**



## **HOLE 3**

**The shortest Par 3 on the course at 113 yards it is also the smallest green.**



## **HOLE 4**

**Long straight Par 4 with a very large bunker on the left fairway that must be avoided. One of the few holes that allows a player to run the ball onto the green.**



## **HOLE 5**

**Another short Par 4 that requires a well hit 2<sup>nd</sup> shot. The green is guarded by a bunker right and is elevated.**



## **HOLE 6**

**Another 3 shot Par 5 requiring a well-placed tee shot followed by a fairway wood setting up a third shot. The two tiered green is elevated and it is crucial to be on the correct level.**



## **HOLE 7**

**131 yard Par 3 with a pond along the entire left side and a large bunker on the right.**





## **HOLE 8**

**After a drive down the center this hole requires a perfect shot to the well protected green. All along the left side is a pond that forces players to favor the right side of the green.**



## **HOLE 9**

**Dogleg right Par 4 with a pond starting at 150 yards from the green. Players will be forced to stay left on this hole which is helped by mounding on the left side.**



## **HOLE 10**

**The back nine starts off with a short Par 4 with a very generous fairway. The green is elevated requiring the player to hit a high shot in order to hold the putting surface.**



## **HOLE 11**

**At 287 yards this is the shortest Par 4 on the course. Players can challenge the fairway bunker on the left side and have a short wedge into the green.**



## **HOLE 12**

**One of the signatures holes this Par 3 plays over a pond from an elevated tee. Club selection is key as the pin placement could change yardage by as much as 3 clubs.**



## **HOLE 13**

**This Par 4 is fairly straight forward until you get to the green. A two tiered green makes placement of your 2<sup>nd</sup> shot very important.**



## **HOLE 14**

**The first of back to back Par 5's this hole is long and straight. The green is guarded by a deep faced bunker on the left side forcing players to attack it with a high third shot or from the right side.**



## **HOLE 15**

**Similar to 14 this hole offers a generous fairway with a deep bunker on the right side. The green is protected by a bunker left and slopes hard from back to front.**





## **HOLE 16**

**This Par 3 requires a carry over a ravine to a well-protected green. Players can bail out right however this leaves a difficult chip shot.**



## **HOLE 17**

**A risk reward Par 4 allows players to cut off a lot of yardage the further down the dogleg left they place their tee shot.**



## **HOLE 18**

**The finishing hole is a true test of golf. A long Par 4 with bunkers right and left make the tee shot difficult. Then a green protected by a large mound right and bunker back left require a precise 2<sup>nd</sup> shot.**
