Last year, she decided to buy some bags from her company when they were on sale. She used her commission plus the donation of money from various individuals to purchase items to fill the bags.

Her purpose was to give them to **people undergoing cancer treatments**. The cost to sponsor a bag is \$40/for the adult cancer patient and \$20/bag for a child that is in the hospital.

Each adult bag generally contains: a fleece blanket, socks, lip balm, ginger chews/ hard candy, coloring book, coloring pencils, a bandana, and a word find book with a mechanical pencil. Each adult bag also contains a personal note. Some sponsors choose to write their own note with encouraging words for the patient receiving the bag.

A bag maybe sponsored in support, memory or in honor of someone known personally.

The Children's Bag contains; crafts items, beanie babies, puzzles, books and other items to occupy the child. . She has already put together 25 bags for children and is now just looking for sponsors. Once the bags have sponsors she will be taking them to **Children's Specialized Hospital** in Toms River.
