RIDER NEEDING LIFT TRANSPORTATION

Riders must call **Ocean Ride** 24-hours in advance - 732-736-8989, press 4

Rider Guidelines:

- No Smoking*
- No Eating or Drinking*
- No Littering*
- Speak softly when using Cell Phones*

- Bus times are approximate.
- Time points on schedule correspond with lettered stops. **You may get on the bus along the route, by signaling to the driver (where roadway conditions permit).**

Route deviation service is available to riders up to one block on either side of the printed bus route where conditions allow. Limit of one deviation per trip will be honored. Riders must call Ocean Ride 24 hours in advance at 732-736-8989 then press 4 for Supervisor.

Ocean Ride reserves the right to authorize appropriate route deviation requests, subject to local regulations.

Drivers cannot make unscheduled route changes.

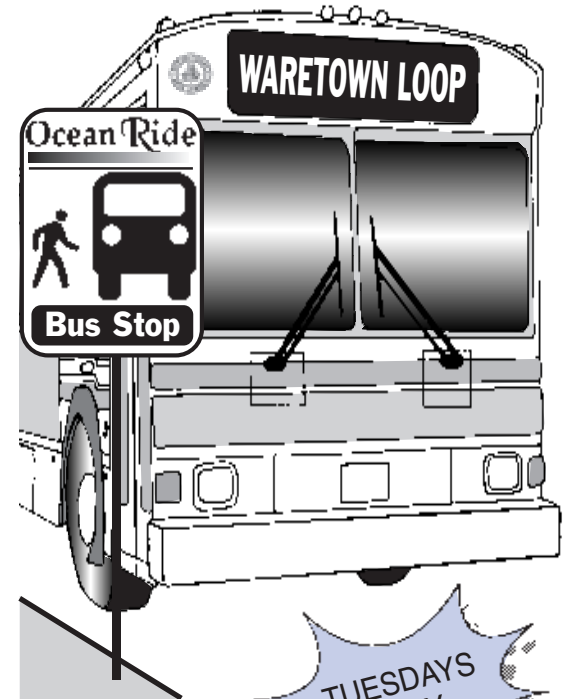



How Do I Sign Up For The Service?

To sign up for Ocean Ride's Waretown service, please call the Ocean Town Hall at **609.693.3302 ext. 221** to reserve your seat or to request further information. Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis based on seating capacity.

Our vehicles are wheelchair-accessible for your convenience. Please advise Town Hall if you require use of the lift so we can allow extra time in our schedule for boarding. In the event of high rider demand, Ocean Ride and the Township of Ocean reserve the right to rotate riders to provide equal access to transportation service by residents.

We ask that you make your reservation each week by calling no later than 4:30 PM the Friday before service. In the event you are unable to ride on your scheduled day of service, please be sure to call Town Hall to cancel your reservation as soon as possible to allow others to ride.

To Request A Schedule

You may request an Ocean Ride schedule for the Waretown service from Ocean Ride at 1.877.929.2082, then press 4. Bus schedules are also available at Ocean Town Hall (Waretown).

Rider Requirements

- Passengers must carry their own package. **Maximum of 2 (two) bags.**
- Packages cannot take up seating capacity or block aisles or exits.
- Drivers may **not** accept tips or gratuities.
