| DATE | TOURNAMENT/SOCIAL | DESCRIPTION |

| April 20 | Pre-Season Play | Regular Tee Times – Scramble Format – Sign-up on Bulletin Board – Pro Shop will form teams. |
| April 27 | Pre-Season Play | Regular Tee Times – Scramble Format – Sign-up on Bulletin Board – Pro Shop will form teams. |
| May 4 | Nine and Wine Cost - \$12.00 for appetizers | 1:00 PM Tee Time Shotgun – playing 9 holes only – closest to the sombrero -Appetizers with Informational Meeting with ProShop Training after play – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |
| May 11 | Scramble with Luncheon to Follow Cost - \$16.00 | Opening Day Scramble - No Team prizes awarded – social event in which everyone hits from the position of the best shot – Door prizes drawings, putting contest, longest and random closest to the pin awards. Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |
| May 18 | 1 Best Ball of Four | Team event in which the best net score of four will be used per hole. |
| May 25 | Step Aside Scramble | Team Event in which everyone tees off and whichever ball is chosen to be used for second shot, that person steps aside, continues on to ball is holed. |
| June 1 | Low Gross/Low Net | Individual event in which the best scores will be awarded with two flights. |
| June 8 | PROVIDENCE HOUSE FUNDRAISER Cost - \$85/\$90 | Continental Breakfast, Scramble, Plated Luncheon, and Merchandise Raffle \$85 for member - \$90 non-members - \$40 lunch only |
| June 15 | Nassau | Prizes given for best front, back, and overall – for 9 holers for first 3, second 3, and third 3 |
| June 22 | Shamble | Like a Scramble, all members of a team (usually 4) tee off and the best ball is selected. All Players move their balls to the spot of the best ball. From this point, the hole is played out at stroke play, with all members of the team playing their own ball into the hole. |
| June 29 | Red, White, Blue, and Green | Team event in which colored ribbons on the flag will correspond to a player, and indicate which players' score will count toward the team score. |
| July 6 | Four Clubs and a Putter | Each golfer chooses a maximum of 4 clubs and a putter to pay the round. |
| July 13 | Step Aside with Luncheon to follow Cost - \$16.00 | No Team score prizes awarded – Social Event in which everyone tees off and whichever ball is chosen to be used for second shot, that person steps aside, continues on to ball is holed. – Door prizes awarded and closest to the pin - Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |

| July 20 | Skins | The Skins game is an individual stroke play event. A skin is won by a player who posts the lowest score on a hole among all those players in the game. The low score must be unique among all scores (no ties). There are potentially 18 skins in an 18 hole match. |
| July 27 | New Game Pink Lady | 4 Person team with predesignated rotating "Pink Ladu". There are two scores for each hole: The net handicap score of the best of the remaining team players and the "Pink Lady" which are then added together |
| August 3 | Low Gross/Low Net | Individual Event in which the best scores are awarded for 2 flights. |
| August 10 | Step Aside Scramble with Luncheon to follow Cost - \$16.00 | No Team Score prizes awarded - Social Event in which everyone tees off and whichever ball is chosen to be used for second shot, that person steps aside, continues on to ball is holed. Door prizes and closest to the pin prizes awarded – Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine Courtesy of Billy Casper |
| August 17 | Shamble | Like a Scramble, all members of a team (usually 4) tee off and the best ball is selected. All Players move their balls to the spot of the best ball. From this point, the hole is played out at stroke play, with all members of the team playing their own ball into the hole. |
| August 24 | Skins | The Skins game is an individual stroke play event. A skin is won by a player who posts the lowest score on a hole among all those players in the game. The low score must be unique among all scores (no ties). There are potentially 18 skins in an 18 hole match. |
| August 31 | Pick Your Own Team Two Best Balls of Four | Team event in which everyone plays their own ball and the two best net scores are added for the team score – Don't have a team, or a full team – no worries pro shop will match you up! |
| September 7 | Criers | Individual Event which each player can delete one score from a par three, a par four, and a par five. |
| September 14 | 1 Best Ball of Four | Team event in which the best net score of four will be used per hole. |
| September 21 | New Game Jokers Wild | 4 person team. Play your game. Each player is designated as a heart, diamond, club, or spade. 2 of each suit plus a joker are placed in an envelope. Prior to playing each hole a random card is drawn. That suit's score is used. Only when the joker is picked is the best score used. Repeat on back nine. |
| September 28 | Scramble with Closing Day Luncheon to follow Cost - \$16.00 | No Team score prizes awarded – Social event in which everyone hits from the position of the best shot. Door prizes putting and other contests and closest to the pin prizes awarded – Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |
