| April 19 | Pre-Season Play | Regular Tee Times – Scramble Format – Sign-up on Bulletin Board – Pro Shop will form teams. |
| April 26 | Pre-Season Play | Regular Tee Times – Scramble Format – Sign-up on Bulletin Board – Pro Shop will form teams. |
| May 3 | Pre-Season Play | Regular Tee Times – Scramble Format – Sign-up on Bulletin Board – Pro Shop will form teams. |
| May 10 | Nine and Wine Cost - \$12.00 for appetizers | 1:00 PM Tee Time Shotgun – playing 9 holes only – closest to the line -Appetizers with Informational Meeting with Pro Shop Staff after play – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |
| May 17 | Scramble with Luncheon to Follow Cost - \$16.00 | Opening Day Scramble - Social event in which everyone hits from the position of the best shot on every shot – Door prize drawings, 1 st & 2 nd place prizes, closest to the line & closest to the pin awards. Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |
| May 24 | 1 Best Ball of Four | Team event in which the best net score of four will be used per hole. |
| May 31 | 1, 2, 3 of 4 New | Team Event in which 1 best score is used for Par 5's, 2 best scores are used for Par 4's and 3 best scores are used for Par 3's. |
| June 7 | Skins | The Skins game is an individual stroke play event. A skin is won by a player who posts the lowest score on a hole among all those players in the game. The low score must be unique among all scores (no ties). There are potentially 18 skins in an 18 hole match. |
| June 14 | PROVIDENCE HOUSE FUNDRAISER Cost - \$85/\$90 | Continental Breakfast, Scramble, Plated Luncheon, and Merchandise Raffle \$85 for member - \$90 non-members - \$40 lunch only |
| June 21 | Low Gross / Low Net | Individual Event in which the best scores are awarded for 2 flights. |
| June 28 | Four Clubs and a Putter | Each golfer chooses a maximum of 4 clubs and a putter to pay the round. |
| July 5 | Red, White, Blue, and Green | Team event in which colored ribbons on the flag will correspond to a player, and indicate which players' score will count toward the team score. |
| July 12 | Step Aside Scramble with Luncheon to follow Cost - \$16.00 | Social Event in which everyone tees off and whichever ball is chosen to be used for the next (2 nd) shot, that person steps aside for that shot, continues on until ball is holed. – Door prize drawings, 1 st & 2 nd place prizes, closest to the line & closest to the pin awards. Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |

| July 19 | Nassau | Prizes given for best front, back, and overall – for the 9 hole players prizes will be for first 3, second 3, and third 3 |
| July 26 | Pick Your Own Team Two Best Balls of Four | Team event in which everyone plays their own ball and the two best net scores are added for the team score – Don't have a team, or a full team – no worries the Pro Shop will match you up! |
| August 2 | Skins | The Skins game is an individual stroke play event. A skin is won by a player who posts the lowest score on a hole among all those players in the game. The low score must be unique among all scores (no ties). There are potentially 18 skins in an 18 hole match. |
| August 9 | Criers | Individual Event which each player can delete one score from a par three, a par four, and a par five. |
| August 16 | Scramble with Luncheon to follow Cost - \$16.00 | Social event in which everyone hits from the position of the best shot on every shot – Door prize drawings, 1 st & 2 nd place prizes, closest to the line & closest to the pin awards. Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine Courtesy of Billy Casper |
| August 23 | Two Best Balls of Four | Team event in which everyone plays their own ball and the two best net scores are added for the team score – Don't have a team, or a full team – no worries pro shop will match you up! |
| August 30 | Low Gross / Low Net | Individual Event in which the best scores are awarded for 2 flights. |
| September 6 | Shamble | Like a Scramble, all members of a team (usually 4) tee off and the best ball is selected. All Players move their balls to the spot of the best ball. From this point, the hole is played out at stroke play, with all members of the team playing their own ball into the hole. |
| September 13 | Skins | The Skins game is an individual stroke play event. A skin is won by a player who posts the lowest score on a hole among all those players in the game. The low score must be unique among all scores (no ties). There are potentially 18 skins in an 18 hole match. |
| September 20 | Pick Your Partner 6-6-6 Nassau New | 2 person team. First 6 holes are a two person Scramble (Both players hit each shot until the ball is holed.) Next 6 holes are a two person Best Ball (Both players play the hole on their own ball and the team takes the best score of the two players.) Last 6 holes are a Modified Alternate Shot (Both players tee off, then each player hits the others ball for their second shot. From there they pick the best of the two and alternate shots until the ball is holed out.) |
| September 27 | Scramble with Closing Day Luncheon to follow Cost - \$16.00 | Social event in which everyone hits from the position of the best shot on every shot – Door prize drawings, 1 st & 2 nd place prizes, closest to the line & closest to the pin awards. Most Improved Golfer for 9 and 18 hole players, Holes – in – One, Ringer, and Birdies/Chip Ins. Lunch to follow in Ballroom – Wine courtesy of Billy Casper |
