

... A WORKING RAIN SENSOR!

This is a photo of what your rain sensor receiver (next to your timer) should look like after a good rainfall, like this morning- Friday May 1 2020.

The red light indicates that the sensor is full and will prevent the system from watering.

When the sensor dries out, the red light will go off and watering will resume with the next scheduled start time.

If your sensor does not look like this after a rainfall, please have it tested.



- **RAIN SENSOR TEST** and battery check:
 - 2 people- one on the ladder, one **holding it**.
 - Press the sensor plunger while sprinklers are on- system should SHUT OFF



If you are handy, this video will show you how to replace the sensor batteries.

Requires 2- 2032 round batteries.
