

Proposed scheduling of the ‘Color’ grouping: Men’s reserved court time is again Monday 8 am to 1 pm; and Thursday 8 am to 1 pm. On Monday’s, three onsite courts are available. Note: **The new ‘Color’ ranking: B=Blue; G=Green; W=White; R=Red. Monday: Level Play. The Legends group has choice.**

Recycle after every 3 weeks. Level play in your color group within one of three (1 hour 40 minute) Monday sessions. That is, 8:00-9:40, 9:40-11:20, 11:20-13:00 (1 pm). Times for each group to vary each Monday, unless no objection to one standard time rotation.

Thursday: Mixed Play. The Legends group has choice.

Recycle after every 3 weeks. Groups play with other color groups within one of two 2 hour Thursday sessions: 8:00-10:00 and 10:00-12:00; or 9:00-11:00, 11:00-13:00 (1 pm). On Thursday of **Week 1**, Blue would mix with White Group in one 2 hour session, and Green would mix with Red in second Two hour session. On Thursday of **Week 2**, Blue would mix with Green in one 2 Hour session, and White would mix with Red in other 2 hour session. On Thursday of **Week 3**, Top half of Blue would play with White and Top half of Red, in one 2 hour session and Bottom half of Blue and Red would play with Green in other. This three week schedule would repeat with variation in the 3rd week each time to mix all the Groups together. Note Week 3 is the only Time that all three Groups would mix, this is in-keeping with the objective to promote more competitive playing opportunities in Week 1 and 2.

Tournaments –

Round Robin: Up to 16 Teams; pairings assigned, seeded, and play in up to 4 brackets with 2 winners advancing out of each Group (of 4) in the Group Stage and would be reseeded in the Quarterfinals, whereupon a single elimination Tournament would follow. This would serve to reduce the number of matches in the Round Robin Tournament to a more manageable number for all Teams and Individuals involved, and eliminate the overlap with the Season ending Club Championship Tournament.

Club Champion : Single Elimination. Players pair themselves, are seeded; play until eliminated.
